The XIII Latvian Song Festival exhibition committee invites all Latvian artists living in Canada to participate in the Festival's Fine Art Exhibition in the Art Gallery of Hamilton, Jean and Ross Fischer Gallery. Deadline for Entry - April 26, 2009.

Each artist may submit up to four (4) works of art, made in the last 5 years, for consideration by the jurors. The artwork must not exceed 130cm. in width, including the frame. Acceptable media: painting, drawing, art photography, mixed media, sculpture. Please send your entries in a digital JPEG or slide format. Good quality colour photographs are acceptable.

Label each image indicating the name of artist, title of the work in English and Latvian, medium, date of completion, size(cm) (vertical before horizontal), orientation, value of work. Submit an image list including the above information, as well as the artist contact information: name, address, tel. number, e-mail address

Include the ten(\$10) application fee.

The organizing committee will receive 20% of the value of the artwork sold.

Entries must be received by April 26, 2009.

AFTER RECEIVING CONFIRMATION FROM THE ART COMMITTEE, PLEASE USE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES FOR ART WORK PREPARATION AND SHIPMENT:

Works must be framed or ready for display professionally. Please use plexiglass instead of glass. Attach to back of the artwork "D-hooks" (they have a hinge and lie relatively flat) and a wire so art is ready for hanging. The work must be securely labelled with artist's name, title (in English and Latvian), medium, date, and value. Package artwork with extreme care. Please use bubblewrap and plastic. Artwork will be insured while at the gallery. After receiving confirmation from the jury, send or deliver artwork to:
